CBS Plans Specials On Warren Report CBS News, which has been investigating the Warren Commission

Report on the assassination of President Kennedy, will present a three-

night examination of the report in June.

The CBS news examination will fill the one-hour period between 10 and 11 PM on Sunday, June 25, Monday, June 26 and Tuesday, June 27, preempting regular programing. Each point of the Warren Report controversy will be examined, CBS News said, including the current investigation being conducted by District Attorney James Garrison of New Orleans.

CBS began its investigation into the report and its critics six months ago, saying that it would present a broadcast on the report if

"it can contribute to public understanding and enlightenment."

Richard S. Salant, news president at CBS, said yesterday: "We have uncovered fresh material and we will present the conclusions of CBS News based on our analysis and investigations. We needed three hours to present the results." Salant said that a single three-hour program would be too much for viewers, and that the decision was therefore made to present it on three nights. It is the first time that any network news special has been presented over three consecutive evenings.
