Assassin Report

There's a lot of competition for your time. At the same hour the above program is on, WTOP-9 will be bringing you the fourth part of "American Assassins." CBS News Correspondent Dan Rather, the reporter for the series, will devote the first half of the program to Sirhan Sirhan and Robert Kennedy, and the second part will deal with George Wallace and Arthur Bremer.

In the Kennedy-Sirhan portion of the program, the theory that there was another gun fired in the pantry of the Ambassador Hotel and the fact that 12 bullet holes were found even though Sirhan's gun only held 8 bullets, will be gone into in detail. Rather will also report on a recent interview he had with Sirhan when they discussed the shooting and the conspiracy theories.

In the second half, George Wallace states that he "does not believe" that Arthur Bremer acted alone. And how a man who had worked as a janitor and bus-boy could have had enough money to do all of the travelling Bremer is known to have done — a question often asked by Wallace — is discussed.
