Yes. This has been pointed out by Harold Weissberg who's raised questions about the integrity of the rep-- the representations which were made about Dr. King's wounds by the County Medical Examiner.

So there's an area of question not only about the accuracy of the autopsy but the accuracy of the testimony about the autopsy.

LESAR:

There is, I would say that it relates certainly to the latter. The former I will refer you to Mr. Weissberg for his evaluation of that.
