Dear Harold :

Here is the transcript of the Daniel Schorr piece which you requested.

I am still biding my time before attempting to follow up on the proposal I have submitted to the program executives here. It seems there is some internecine warfare to decide which unit is really going to carry the ball on the assassination story. I would rather not be too specific on this point, except to say that, despite their apparent committment for a program in November, the essential work has not yet begun.

Regarding the spectro story, I firmly believe it belongs in the context of a special report rather than a spot news story on The Evening News. For the well-informed, the story would have great impact, but for the average viewer-listener, the spectro story is too obscure---it requires too much in the way of background explanation.

What we must do ("we" meaning the independent researchers and the "underground" here at CBS News) is to help created a preponderance of evidence instead of letting it come out **press** piece by piece. While you and I may have our philosophical differences about this point, I remain convinced that the spectro information, as well as the new medical evidence, should come out as part of a new and meaningfully structured study, such as the one I am hoping to see at CBS News.

Unless I am severely disappointed, Harold, I believe that all of us are going to make history this year. Perhaps we*ll even change it.
