Dear George,

Reassuring as you were I phoned earlier today, the thought that I may have misspoken myself and mentioned the name of Henry Wade in a context referring to Justice of the Peace Johnston haunts me. Henry Wade was not the third of the officials who told the ACLU Oswald wanted no attorney. He was the district attorney, and he had had FBI experience, and he should have seen to it that the legal rights of the accused were honored, but he did not, to the best of my knowledge, turn the ACLU away. I fear that unintentionally what I said gives the impression he did.

Because I know you and CBS sent the kind of scrupulous attention to accuracy I hope characterizes WHITEWASH, I'd appreciate it if you'd take no chance and ask New York to check for this and ~~eliminate~~ ^{edit} it if the error is on the tape.

Thanks a lot. Some nice things have happened since I saw you, including an offer for the book. I'll tell you when I speak to you about anything new that develops.
