FREEDOM OF INFORMATION APPEAL



Dear Mr. Levi:

On December 7, 1975, I made a Freedom of Information request on behalf of Mr. Harold Weisberg for all pages of Warren Commission Document 1347 which are now withheld or which have been withheld at any time since 1967. By letter dated December 23, 1975, FBI Director Clarence Kelley informed me that the National Archives will make "available" the FBI's decision on the disclosure of this document "in the very near future."

Since this is both non-responsive and dilatory, as is customary, I am treating Director Kelley's answer as a denial of Mr. Weisberg's request and I hereby appeal that denial.
