Officer Who Recounted CIA Break-in Promoted

Robert L. Fleck, the Fairfax City policeman who disclosed the roles members of his department played in assisting a Central Intelligence Agency sponsored break in 1971, has been promoted and given a \$2,386.a-year raise.

Fleck, 45, a member of the 45-member city force since 1967, was one of two officers selected for promotion from supporal to sergeant. Fleck's annual salary will go from \$15,104 to \$17,490 with the promotion, which was effective July 1.
