

Leland B. Hogle, Was CIA Officer

Leland B. Hogle, 70, a federal employee for 26 years, died Thursday at Arlington Hospital following a stroke.

Born in Young America, Minn., Mr. Hogle was educated in North Dakota. He graduated from North Dakota State Teachers College and taught in North Dakota public schools until he came to Washington in 1941.

Mr. Hogle began his government career as a clerk with the Civil Service Commission and became an investigator for the commission. He was transferred to the Central Intelligence Agency where he was a liaison officer. He retired in 1967.

He is survived by his wife, Hazel G. Hogle, of the home, 1117 S. Quincy St., Arlington; a son, Glenn L. of Arlington; two sisters, Luella Freswick of Alberta, Canada, and Lois E. Anderson of Chicago, and a granddaughter.
