

Myron Toloczko, CIA Officer

Myron Toloczko, who worked for the Central Intelligence Agency for 21 years, died Thursday of cardiorespiratory arrest at Fairfax Commonwealth Doctors Hospital. Mr. Toloczko, 55, retired from the CIA last June.

He was born in Darby, Pa. From 1941 to 1952, he served at headquarters battalion 2d Marine Division in Iwo Jima, Maui, Guam, and Germany. He graduated from the Georgetown University

Foreign Service School in 1957.

Mr. Toloczko's career as an operations officer in the CIA began in 1954. He served with the CIA in Europe, the Middle East and in this country.

He is survived by his wife, Theresa, and five children, Marc, Matthew, John, Marcia and Michael, all of the home in Fairfax; a sister, Kay Sniger, of Somerton, Pa.; two brothers, Steve, of Cornwell Heights, Pa., and William, of Westville, N. J.
