

Castro Wonders ^{Post}

STOCKHOLM — ^{2.4.75} Cuban Prime Minister Fidel Castro was quoted in the newspaper Dagens Nyheter as saying he knew of at least a dozen CIA efforts to assassinate him, but added that he thinks that the United States is no longer interested in having him killed.

"I think that they have accepted the Cuban revolution," he said in the interview, "but one can't be completely sure."
