Chilean General Accused

SANTIAGO, Chile—The former head of Chile's secret police, who is now under Indictment in the United States in connection with the bombing death of former Chilean ambassador Orlando Letelier, shipped documents related to the killing out of Chile by freighter, according to the daily tabloid La Segunda.

The newspaper said Brig. Gen. Juan Manuel Contreras had a suitcase full of documents shipped out in April with a load of luggage aboard a West German ship bound for Europe.

The weekly news magazine Que Pasa, partly owned by Foreign Minister Hernan Cubillos, urged the government to comment.
