Per your request, on 18 May 1971 [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] of the [REDACTED] of the Technical Division and the writer met at the Montgomery County Police Headquarters, Rockville, Maryland, with the Superintendent, Montgomery County Police, Col. 2. The outcome of the meeting that covered several topics is as follows:
