MEMORANDUM FOR: Headquarters

SUBJECT: LIAISON WITH MUNICIPAL AGENCIES
(Photography and Surveillance Training)

1. Attached are outlines for courses in Photography and Surveillance to be given by this office to selected members of the Police Departments of Montgomery County, Prince George's County, Fairfax County, Arlington County, and the District of Columbia.

2. At the present time, it is estimated that a total of forty-eight (48) trainees from these Departments may attend these courses. No indication was forthcoming, however, as to how many trainees from each Department might be released at one time to attend. In this connection, it is suggested that consonant with the classroom and darkroom space available, each Department be assigned a quota for each course. The total course preferences and number of trainees from each Department are as follows:

3. As to manpower and equipment to be provided by [redacted], at least one instructor and an assistant will be required for both the Photography and Surveillance Courses. In addition, agent personnel and radio-equipped vehicles will be required for participation in the field problems. The number of agents and vehicles required will, of course, depend upon the number of trainees per course. With respect to the Surveillance Training

Course, I would like to point out that from eight to ten trainees per course is about the limit the [REDACTED] will be able to provide for with its present assets in manpower and equipment. To attempt to provide for more would tend to make the course unwieldy and less effective.

4. With respect to costs, it is estimated that costs for the Photography Course will amount to approximately \$15.00 per trainee. Except for agent mileage and operating expenses for the office cars, no other costs are anticipated for the Surveillance Training.
