The training which is to be given by the consists of one week of photographic training, and they advised that they can accommodate five (5) students, or one (1) from each of the local police jurisdictions. They also propose one week of surveillance training and advise that they can accommodate ten (10) students or two (2) from each of the local jurisdictions. The details are outlined in Attachment A. Space in Division, OS and in was inspected by Special Agent felt that the space provides better accommodations. That space is available from 17 July through 18 August 1972. was contemplating providing the training for the period 17 through 28 July 1972. While it appears that the photography training could proceed with help from another field office, the surveillance training, which normally follows the photography, would be hampered insofar as practical problem exercises are concerned, if the present exercise and its need for manpower and vehicles continues, and if the target date for the training is fixed for July. 4.
