

Soviets Play Up

U.S. Spy Charges

MOSCOW, Jan. 25 (UPI)—
The Soviet press is having a
field day with charges of ille-
gal CIA spying in the United
States.

Reports of CIA men shadow-
ing U.S. citizens, eavesdrop-
ping on their telephone con-
versations and opening their
mail are receiving prominent
display in Soviet newspapers
and magazines.

A Tass news agency re-
ported from New York head-
lined, "U.S.A.—Total Spying,"
said "spying on suspects and
dissidents in the U.S.A. has as-
sumed a genuinely threaten-
ing scale in recent years." It
attributed the assessment to
"the U.S. press."
