"The President never really made any special effort to find out if there were any files on himself," the press

"He assumes, without really knowing for sure, that the fact that friends of his were nominated and checked out for Federal jobs and he was visited by the F.B.I.—as some of you, no doubt, have been when your friends have been nominated—ard he assumes that out of that kind of contact with the F.B.I. there must be some sort of information at the F.B.I. that relates to him."
