DEFENDANT'S OPPOSITION TO PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF

Defendant, by its attorney, the United States Attorney, in opposition to plaintiff's motion for injunctive relief restraining the Director and employees of the CIA from destroying documents, states as follows:

1. It is clear that the CIA, its Director and employees are not defendants in the instant action and, accordingly, are not proper subjects of an injunctive order in this action.

2. It is likewise clear that the documents plaintiff seeks in the instant action, i.e., three transcripts of the Warren Commission, are held by GSA in the National Archives, and are not held by the CIA.

3. Defendant's counsel has been informed that the CIA is under a moratorium preventing destruction of documents which would likely include any documents plaintiff might seek in another action.

WHEREFORE, defendant respectfully requests the Court to deny plaintiff's motion for injunctive relief.
