4 August 1972 New York Times, front page, at bottom of column 6 (reading from left to right) carried the following two-line ad in 6-point agate type used for want ads:

PEKING MAN. Emp. St. Obs, mtg. Funds avail.; no questions. Phone C.G.J.--Advt.

This apparently refers to a meeting Christopher G. Janus says he had with a woman on the observation deck of the Empire State Building.
