## **Senate Given Plans To Oversee CIA Actions**

Two proposals designed to subject the Central Intelli-gence Agency to closer con-gressional scrutiny were of-fered in the Senate yesterday. Sen. Eugene J. McCarthy (D-Minn.) called for creation of a special Senate foreign rela-tions subcommittee to make a "full and complete study" of the effects of CIA operations on foreign relations of the United States.

Sen. Stephen M. Young (D-Ohio) introduced a proposal which would establish a joint Senate-House committee, on a permanent basis, to oversee CIA operations.

Both senators, in floor state-ments accompanying their proposals, said CIA has been making policy as well as carry-ing it out.
