

the air. American ground troops, the 150,000 or so that remain, are engaged almost entirely in packing up to go home or in protecting others while they do so. About 4,300 more GIs mostly from medical and emgineer units, began preparing to withdraw today.

But the air war, as last week's round-the-clock bombings show, is far from over and can break out thunder ously at any time over both vietnams, Laos and Cambodia.
