You have not acted on my appeal for a waiver of charges. I have provided proof that my work and interest are public rather than for personal gain. The courts and the Department of Justice have so found and the Department has waived fees and refunded what I had paid. Now I have read that a court has held that under these condition the CIA also may not assess charges. I therefore write to remind you of this and other appeals on which you have not acted, some relating to requests now almost eight years old.

If you require more information that I have provided please ask for it.

I would like to know when you expect to act on these quite old appeals.

I also would like to know when to expect the balance of the JFK assassination material.

In particular I would like to know when to expect the Nosenko information your affidavits in one of my cases claim was declassified for the House Select Committee on Assassinations.
