New Paisley Twist.

Former CIA man John A. Paisley's wife and hery lawyer, (who stand to gain considerable if a Newey York insurance company pays off on a life insurance policy), are coming up with loads of new evidence indicating foul play in the mystery sailboat death of Paisley. The latest, revealed in the Wilmington, Del., News Journal, is that Paisley's Washington apartment was broken into while Paisley was taking his last sail aboard the sloop "Brillig." Paisley's death was ruled a suicide by state police, but Washington lawyer Bernard Fensterwald and Paisely's widow, Maryann have insisted he was murdered. Now Eddie Paisley, 22, the CIA official's son, says he was asked by his mother to check on the apartment when Paisley's empty sailboat was found drifting. He discovered that papers were strewn about and a camera, tape recorder and tapes of family history were all missing. Also found were 9 millimeter bullets, the same type that caused the single headwound which caused Paisley's death.
