> On July 8, 1964, Mrs. JEANN ALLRED, 9421 Lake North Circle, Apartment A, Dallas, Texas, advised that a is the former wife of JAMES V. ALLRED, Jr. Mrs. ALLRED Texas, advised that she denied stating that she had ever seen an envelope addressed to her husband bearing the name LEE HARVEY OSWALD. Mrs. ALLRED stated that she has thrown away most of the material formerly belonging to her husband. Mrs. ALLRED further stated that it is her recollection that her former husband belonged to an organization called the Youth Freedom Society which Mrs. ALLRED described as being the same organization which LEE HARVEY OSWALD had belonged to in New Orleans, and which was pro-Cuban. Mrs. ALLRED stated it was her understanding that OSWALD was passing out material for the Youth Freedom Society when he was arrested by the New Orleans, Louisiana police in August of 1963. Mrs. ALLRED further claimed that she recalled seeing copies of "The Worker" which Mrs. ALLRED described as a Communist Party publication published in New York City. As to the radical beliefs of her former husband, Mrs. ALLRED stated that her former husband would do anything for money and she does not have any proof that he is in any way assisting Cuba. However, she feels that he is capable of such an act because of his unscrupulous character.





"The author's book has undoubtedly added to the malaise about the assassination that is felt to a great degree in Europe and to a lesser degree in America.

"The book will be published in America on November 22.

"Mr. BUCHANAN, 45, has lived in Paris for the last three years but was back in Baltimore yesterday.

"Was Army Captain

"He went to Calvert School, Lawrenceville, Yale and George Washington University and was an Army captain in France during World War II.

"Mr. BUCHANAN is a soft-spoken man, quick with his facts but not beyond a flash of humor as he dredges through the stack of documents he has accumulated on the Dallas tragedy.

"That stack of documents included the Warren report summary, yesterday.

"'It is a mass of data accumulated by the commission staff, of immeasurable value in attempting to understand the events of November 22.

"But the interpretation given to this data by the commission seems to me to be unjustified in many respects.

"'Notably, the explanation of how OSWALD received a passport in 1963...and the explanation as to how the murder weapon was identified at first as a 7.65 Mauser' and later said to be an Italian carbine of different caliber.





> In reading the information contained herein, it is important to bear in mind that Pascual Gongora is presently an imate at Creedmore State Mental Hospital, Quens, New York, where medical authorities have labeled him as Psychotic.

> Of additional interest is the fact that Attorney James Egan is attempting to obtain the release from Creedmore of Gongora on the basis of a writ of habeaus corpus. A hearing date for Gongora is now set for June 6, 1967.

On February 28, 1967, a feature article appeared in El Tiempo, one of New York's daily Spanish newspapers, written by Editor Stanley Ross, which alleged that Premiær Fidel Castro of Cuba sent eight teams to the United States for the purpose of assassinating President John F. Kennedy. In addition, Ross was interviewed on several radio and television news programs being broadcasted in the New York vicinity, at which time he made statements similar to those appearing in the newspaper article.

In substance, Ross claimed that Gongora had informed American authorities three days prior to the President's assassination that Castro interbed to order President Kennedy killed, and that this plan was to be carried out by six to eight teams sent to the United States by Castro. According to Ross, Gongora was suspected of being a Cuban agent by the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

When he was picked up three days prior to the assassination he freely admitted that he was a member of one of the teams sent to New York to await the opportunity of killing the President. Other teams were said to have been sent to other cities such as Dallas where the President was due to make visits. Gongora is quoted as having said that Castro was convinced that Kennedy was planning to have him killed as he had done to Ngo Dinh Diem of Vietnam, and that Castro decided to kill Kennedy before he, Kennedy, got him. Ross related that when the President was assassinated Gongora was in the Immigration and Naturalization Service building in Manhattan and that the North American authorities did not know what to do with their prisoner. They feared that if they announced his detention, the public, in fury and sadness over Kemedy's death, would kill innocent and defenseless Cuban anti-Castroites in the streets. As a result, the authorities sought permission from Mexico and Canada to deport Gongora to Cuba via their countries. Both countries refused to do it. Finally, Spain agreed to send Gongora back to Cuba, but the Castro government was afraid and refused to recognize Gongora as one of their agents. Ross went on to say that it would not be surprising to him if Gongora were still in the United States under another name, inasmuch as he, Ross, claimed to have knowledge that Gongora had suggested to the authorities at Immigration and Naturalization Service that they send him to KeyWest, Florida. 


