The double numbers have been added by the CIA. The first number is apparently a sequence number for the re-review which is currently going on. The second number is the one assigned to the document during the first review: Items 1-521 were released, and items 522-1129 were listed for Bud but not released.

Additional documents have been given numbers from the original sequence (1-521) followed by a letter. These suffixed items are not necessarily related - Item 170-57A happens to be an attachment to Item 57, but Item 672-286A is completely unrelated to Item 286.

Items with suffixes, and items with numbers above 521, are therefore completely new. Many pages in this file were released before, but with more deletions.

In the above lists, for old items the number of new (i.e., additional) pages is given in parentheses. New items are indicated by "*", and additional items by a page count followed by "+".

This batch appears to be the result of a re-review of material through roughly mid-May, 1964 - that is, through 295 of the 521 previously released (in part or full) items, and through #834 of the previously withheld but listed items. Many of the additional items appear to be Warren Commission correspondence. (In at least a few cases, copies of documents obtained from the Archives have been sent, instead of the actual CIA copies.)
