 - ✓ b. The memorandum for Mr. Howard Willens from A. W. Dulles dated 22 July 1964 can be released. (Ltr 24), 20
 - ✓ c. Memorandum to Arlen Specter from Slawson dated 13 March 1964, Subject: Takins Testimony of Doctors. Can be released. (Ltr 1), 1
 - ✓ d. Memorandum to Rankin from Slawson dated 4 June 1964, Subject: Telephone conference with CIA. Release except for name. (Executive Order 11652, Paragraph 5 (B)(2)). (Ltr 1), 1
 - ✓ e. Letter to Helms from Rankin dated 2/7/64 can be downgraded to CONFIDENTIAL. (Ltr 10), 9
 - ✓ f. The letter to McCone from Rankin dated 16 November 1964 can be released; but all names except for Richard Helms should be withheld (5(B)(2)). (Ltr 2), 6
 - ✓ g. 00-B-3,284,733 dated 17 December 1963 should not be released and should continue to be classified CONFIDENTIAL. (Ltr 1), 1
 - ✓ h. Revised Draft M/R from Slawson dated 27 March 1964 can be downgraded to CONFIDENTIAL. (Ltr 1), 1

dated 9 March 1964 can be released except for the
last paragraph which should be classified CONFIDENTIAL,
5(B)(2).
- l. Memorandum for Rankin from Helms ^{Let 2, 12}
dated 21 January 1964, Subject: Draft Questions for Sub-
mission to the Government of the Soviet Union can
be released.
- m. Memorandum for Rankin from Helms ^{Let 2, 2}
dated 22 January 1964, Subject: Suggested Questions for
Marina Oswald, can be released.
- n. Memorandum to Willens from Slawson ^{Let 1, 2}
dated "Feb 1964", Subject: Letter to the Russian Government,
can be released.
- o. Memorandum to Rankin from Coleman and Slawson ^{Let 1,}
dated 15 April 1964, Subject: Progress in Area 3
(Oswald's Foreign Travels) and a Numbered Checklist
of Work Remaining to be done Prior to Preparation of
