## CABAL SUMMARY

As outlined by Cabal, the plot to assassinate President Kennedy involved more than a dozen prominent Americans, among them L.B.J., J. Edgar Hoover, Walter Jenkins, Fred Korth, Bobby Baker and Werner von Braun.

The assassination was planned and supervised by Division Five of the FBI--an assassination bureau in existence since 1943 -- at the direction of J. Edgar himself.

L.M. Bloomfield of Montreal is alleged to have been the top co-ordinator for the network planning the execution. Permindex was used to front five organizations which provided the personnel for the assassination. These five groups are: 1) an exile organization known as the "Solidarists", headed by Ferenc Nagy and JOhn De Menil; 2) a section of the American Council of Christian Churches, headed by H.L. Hunt; 3) the Free Cuba Committee, headed by Carlos Prio Socarras; 4) an organization of U.S., Carribean and Havana gamblers known as "The Syndicate" and headed by Clifford Jones, ex-lieutenant governor of Nevada, and Bobby Baker; 5) The Security Division of NASA, headed by Werner Von Braun and headedquartered at DISC (Defense Industrial Security Command) offices at Muscle Shoals Redstone Arsenal in DISC 46+5 Alabamba and on East Broad Street in Columbus, Ohio. There is a lot of material in Cabal which, to my knowledge, has not been previously published. The most interesting of this material relates to Division Five of the FBI, Osborne-Bowen, the Buddy Floyd assassination case, DISC, and the Soldarists. There appears to be some valuable information in these areas.

However, it should be noted that citations are vague (e.g. "New Orleans District Attorney REcords", "Buddy Floyd case files") or erroneous or do not appear to support the inferences drawn from the material cited. Moreover, we have not been given access to the back-up documentation. In short, without a good deal of careful attention, which I have not yet given it, it is very hard to assess the reliability of Cabal.

There is also one other very interesting fact which must be kept in mind: Cabal, by fixing blame on J. Edgar and Company, absolves the CIA.
