We received information that the above subject was arrested running from the City Hall after the shooting of Lee Harvey Cowald.

I contacted Sergeant, J. F. Everett December 13, 1963. Sorgeant Everett stated as follows:

"I was on duty in the Dispatcher's Office and had walked into the hall of the third floor at the time of the shooting. Democrae shouted to secure the building and I ran down the store to the first floor. There I saw the subject william Collinsy run towards the Harwood Street exit. Sergeant Pubnica, Officer R. T. Davis #1887 and myself apprehended the subject on the stops of the City Hall. He was taken to the Remieide Durenu and interrogated by Detective T. L. Laker. It was determined this subject was apparently sightseeing on the first floor. He was later released.

This person works for Cockrell and Winniford, 2712 Live Cak, Tulupa one TA4-6741 - Home Phone, CA4-3419."

This investigation of William Coffney has not been carried any farther at this time.
