I acknowledge receipt of your letter dated the 3/29/70 informing me that you are going to send me more information about Lucy M. Cain, expecting it will be - - soon, so it will save time to get through with this investigation.

I am enclosing more pictures of Richard S. Cain, with his finger prints taken by the FBI, that will be - - very useful for you. Cain, when in Mexico City, brought a "Lies Detector" and used to call people to train them in this subject. It was located in the streets of Salamanca and Sinalca, but it had to be closed when Cain was deported from Mexico.

... of Yucatan, he had some activities in that place. I wrote - - so a friend of mine that belongs to the Police, named Ernesto Abreu Gómez, inquiring about Cain; but he has not - - answered me.

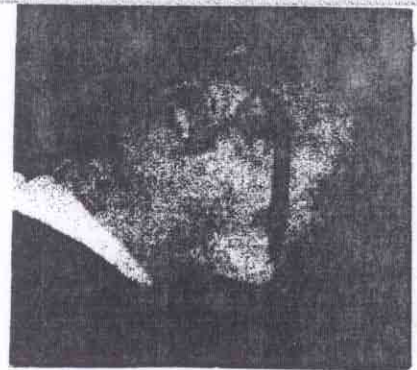
"En contestación a su atento oficio número 30342, de fecha 14 de Diciembre anterior, me permito manifestarle que existe un antecedente en esta Secretaría de un norteamericano de nombre **RICHARD CAL**, quien se internó al País por el Puerto Central de esta Capital el día 28 de Julio de 1961 en calidad de No Inmigrante comprendido en la excepción del Artículo 50 de la Ley General de Población. Dicho extranjero fué expulsado del País por el citado Puerto Aéreo el día 1 de Junio de 1962, en virtud de haber proporcionado datos falsos en relación con su calidad migratoria".

Lo que me permito transcribir a Ud. para su conocimiento y como resultado de lo escrito a que en un principio hago referencia.

In reference to your letter dated Dec 7 1962 in relation to the deportation of Mr. Richard Cain, I am glad to send you the information received from Lic, Rafael Hernandez Ochoa, Sub-Director General de Poblacion de la Secretaria de Gobernacion of this City, to whom we solicited the information. In official paper No.2984, Exp. 4/351.3"61"/48963, dated 15 of this month, it is written:

"In answer to your official paper No.39392, dated 14 of Dec. I wish to inform you that there is proof in this office pertaining a North-American by the name of Ricard Cain, who intern himself in this country by via Puerto Central Aereo of this City the 28th of July 1961 as a non emigrant, as stated in Fraccion III of Article 50 of the General Law of the Country, This foreigner was expelled from this Country via Puerto Aereo the 4th of June 1962 in view of the fact that his emigrant papers were false.".....
