ANOTHER CAPTURE: The political organization put together by House candidate Ronny Caire has pulled the second organization name capture of the current campaign.

Miss Jennie Brown, a candidate for the Orleans Democratic Executive Committee, has reserved the name of the Independent Women's Organization through the office of Secretary of State Wade O. Martin.

The IWO, like the Affiliated Council of Democratic Organizations, was never incorporated, even though it dates back to the early days of the late Chep Morrison's term in office.

A telegram has been to sent to Mrs. Samuel Wilson, head of the IWO, to the effect that members should cease "illegal use" of the IWO name. This would presumably include the issuance of a ballot.

The IWO did not endorse either Miss Brown or Caire, a candidate for the House from Wards 14 and 16.

Meanwhile, the ACDO has its name back. In the words of one of the politicians who masterminded the pre-emption of Mayor Victor H. Schiro's organization label, "an agreement was reached."

The agreement, of course, required a promise from the ACDO that its endorsements would not be altered. There had been talk a couple of weeks ago that the ACDO would go back into session and substitute an endorsement of incumbent Sen. Olaf Fink for that of Gus Betz.
