Louise Campbell of "Science" magazine called the Bureau on 3/23/64, and asked for SA John F. Gallagher of the Laboratory. She advised that she had an Atomic Energy Commission publication relating to neutron activation analyses which reported that this analytical technique was being adapted to crime detection. She made general inquiries relating to the technical aspects of this technique. Then she inquired as to the employment of this technique in the Oswald case. She was told there would be no comment on this subject. She stated that she might include the fact that there was no comment to the Oswald inquiry in the "Science" magazine article on neutron activation analyses. However, before this was printed she might have to check further. She then advised she would think about it. Louise Campbell is unknown to SA Gallagher and she would not say where she obtained his name. Mr. DeLoach's office was telephonically advised immediately following the call.
