If your show received any attention here I have not seen or heard it. The one reaction I've had from a reporter who saw a showing is that while it was interesting he felt that it stretched quite a bit on the gangland stuff.

I am still interested in seeing a transcript if you made one and of having a sound tape to hear.

I know nothing of what you aired or of your outtakes, save for the one provocative sound tape.

When it is possible to arrange safe return of what you retrieved from the French for me I'd like to get it back. The Zapruder print is as good a one as there is outside the original, from which it was made. However, if you want to do any work with it, like making copies or special copies, there is no rush on returning any of it. Ditto for the other films.

Charlier did not keep his word, to send me a representation of what he aired, as well as an account of uses outside of France. There was such airing because I got a reaction to it from Copenhagen. All I know of what he did aside from here and with me is that he interviewed James Earl Ray and James T. Tague.

A free-lance is doing a show for BBC. He might want access to my film. I'll know more in about 10 days, when I expect a visit.
