As I told you we would, we made arrangements to put Scott Breckenridge in touch with Senators Schweiker and Hart to discuss the draft of the study of the Warren Commission-Kennedy Assassination materials that the two Senators have been involved in.

The attached memorandum shows that we have had our day in court and that that day was not an entirely pleasant one.

In subsequent discussions it appears quite possible that the final report will include some of the points raised by Scott, though, there is unlikely to be any major change in the thrust of the report as it now stands.

The prospect is for publication of the report sometime within the next ten days or so. We've done as much as I think advisable and I think now that we hunker down and take no further steps to persuade the authors of our convictions that the facts do not square with their conclusions.
