SUBJECT: Jack Anderson Article dated 9 September 1976

The attached memorandum for the record, Subject: Jack Anderson Column, "CIA Withheld Data in JFK Probe" dated 13 September 1976, is in response to your request for further information on the Jack Anderson column of 9 September 1976 which appeared in the Washington Post.

With regard to your query as to the identity of attorney Edward R. Morgan who was mentioned in the article, he is a former FBI official and a long-time associate and attorney for Robert Maheu, formerly with the Howard Hughes organization. Mr. Morgan was the attorney for John Roselli and represented Roselli in the late 60's at deportation procedings and the so-called Friar's Club Swindle Case. I understand that during the deportation procedings against Roselli, Morgan tried to blackmail the Agency into quashing these procedings by threatening that Roselli would "tell all.". This would indicate that Mr. Morgan was aware of Roselli's role in the Castro assassination plotting.
