PH, JNS,

My volunteer translator did not appear, did not phone to say he would not. He was due 7/6. He had phoned me twice, the first a rather long call of which I have a good record. He says he has worked for the Library of Congress for years, is a translator, earlier experience Air Force, where he translated Russian intercepts. These included Powers and earlier overflights which, he says, included transiting flights by RB47s.

Second call told me he was leaving end of month, retiring partial disabilities (totally \$700 monthly) but that he had arranged Univ Miami employment which, while cutting his retirement by \$300, would give him greater gross and something to do.

Said fluent in 7 languages, claimed lapse more than 17 years ended security restrictions on his knowledge. Name Callerton.

Professed interest JFK assassination, desire to get PW, belief in conspiracy (red), involving LHO.

Id I hear more, which is doubtful, I'll let you know.
