Many thanks for your letter of December 9. I shall try as you suggest. I had already asked the State Archives for this material, I am disappointed to tell you, without success.

There is another point on which I hope you will get interested. I am certain you will recall your rush trip to Washington on the rumor Oswald was a government agent. The record on that, in Washington, does not exist or is not credible, both being true. Therefore, I would like to ask that you record your best recollection of the entire thing as soon as possible, for a dependable record on this is very important.

I would very much like a copy of this. But whether or not you give it to me, I do encourage you to make the best possible record. I think your personal reputation and that of Texas require this.

My searched in the National Archives on this subject are discouraging. Those records which should exist do not. I cannot regard this as accidental. The responses and lack of responses to my inquiries are not encouraging.

I am making and keeping the best record I can. I have already promised to make it available to Texass when it is as complete as I can hope.

Ultimately, I am confident, when you learn what you may not now know, you will conclude as I have: You people were had. With you, so was history.
