Carr Arraigned 7-12-77

DALLAS—Waggoner Carr, once Texas' top law officer, was arraigned yesterday on four charges before U.S. Magistrate Patrick Mulloy and made bond totaling \$3,500.

He was indicted Monday on charges of mail and wire fraud and falsification of reports to the securities and Exchange Commission.

The indictments grew out of investigation into the Sharpstown bank and stock fraud scandals.

The former Texas attorney-general turned up alone to surrender at the U.S. marshal's office in the Dallas Federal Building.
