When I was in New Orleans in early November, though Ed Devenport of WML Radio, Dr. Caseriego was willing to talk to me. At that time it was impossible, for by then I was ready to leave. He made several efforts to get in touch with im Carrison, which failed.

He had been in charge of the Cuban propaganda broadcasts on WWL. He was then teaching at Cardinal Rummel school (telephone of administrative office 821-1650).

When I returned to New Orleans in December I attempted to see him. He was reported to be sick, to be going to school for his classes end then going home to bed. He spoke to me just before I left end explained that he had been troubled by a malady that impairs his speech, that when he has it he has to speek very little or he loses his voice entirely.

He expressed a willingness to liscuss what he knew at a future date, with me or someone from the DA's office. I suggested that until then he try and recall what and who connected with the cerious suban groups or the matters he broadc at he thought night be pertinent to the investigation.

His home thome is 835-6579. The thome for the same name on Louisiene Avenue Parkway, 821-1350, is that of a relative.
