Castillo told them that an-other man had dismantled his other man had dismantled his rifle after they heard that some-body called Joe had already "got the man." Then he had driven to the airport and flown to Chicago. Questioned by reporters, Cas-tillo, who never raised his eyes, said that he had lost his mem-

ory apparently because he had been given drugs while in the U. S.
