

New Suspect In a JFK 'Plot'

Manila, April 21 (Reuters)—
Philippines police today pro-
duced at a press conference
here a 24-year-old Puerto Rican
who they think could have been
involved in the assassination of
President Kennedy.

They said that, while under the
influence of a truth serum, the
Puerto Rican, handsome Luis
Angel Castillo, said he was one
of a group of about 15 men
assigned to kill "the President."

He was given a rifle and put
in a high building with instruc-
tions to shoot a man who could
be in an open car in a motor-
cade together with a woman
and another man.

Castillo told them that an-
other man had dismantled his
rifle after they heard that some-
body called Joe had already
"got the man." Then he had
driven to the airport and flown
to Chicago.

Questioned by reporters, Cas-
tillo, who never raised his eyes,
said that he had lost his mem-
ory apparently because he had
been given drugs while in the
U. S.
