

Cuba Denies JFK Death Role

Prime Minister Fidel Castro denies that Cuba had anything to do with the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

"I can categorically affirm that the Cuban revolution never had the most minor participation in the death of the president of the United States, John Kennedy," Castro said, according to a Havana Radio broadcast monitored in Miami.

Castro made the comment in a speech in which he discussed attempts he said were carried out against Cuban leaders in the early days of the Cuban revolution.
