FROM WILLIS POSITION THE PRESIDENT'S HEAD APPEARS AT A SPOT SLIGHTLY LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS OF THE DISTANCE FROM THE CENTER OF THE LAHPPOST TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF ZAPRUDE'S PERCH.
