This photograph is an enlargement of a tiny one from Commission Exhibit 2114, simply labeled "highway markings in the vicinity of the assassination" in the index.

This is one of a large number of exhibits (1054 through 3154) never mentioned or introduced at the hearings and which are buried in the last 5 volumes of the 26. The photograph is undated, but, since the same floral tributes are on the grass as in the pictures from Exhibit 875 taken on December 5, 1963, it must have been taken after November 22, 1963 and before the Stemmons sign was removed for the Secret Service re-enactment of December 5, 1963.

Notice how the foliage on the sides of the tree seem to have been "doctored" out. Compare with Willis #5 and with the photograph from Exhibit 875 and notice how straight the lines are on the side branches. No tree ever grew with squared-off side branches.
