P R E S S R E L E A S E

Now we have another lie in behalf of the federal government's false and fraudulent "investigation" of the Kennedy assassination. President Johnson's lie machine is now so deeply involved in falsehoods that new lies are required to keep the old lies alive. This time, however, the lie machine is caught not only by a revealing photograph but by a letter taken from its own records.

Of course, Deputy Sheriff Walthers denies that the bullet is a bullet. If he did not, he would not be Deputy Sheriff any longer. The official fairy tale has been spelled out loud and clear and all men who value their jobs and their lives know what answers the lie machine expects them to give. Consequently, Deputy Sheriff Walthers is reduced to the embarrassment of having to pretend that the federal official in the photographs has, in the first photograph, reached down for a piece of the President's head -- and, in the second photograph, is holding a piece of the President's head firmly clutched in his hand.

What is important is that Deputy Sheriff Walthers initially said that he did find a bullet -- which conforms exactly to the photograph which has caught him standing about 18 inches from the bullet and looking at it. But this was before Lyndon Johnson's administration indicated the official line that it was going to be pretended that there was only one assassin and that all bullets had to come from his ancient Italian rifle -- otherwise they did not exist. Since the bullet shown in our photograph was of a much larger caliber than the Mannlicher-Carcano which Oswald was supposed to have used, Mr. Walthers had to back away and disclaim his original statement that he had found the bullet.

Consequently, the bullet officially became a non-bullet and disappeared. That this is what occurred is indicated by the attached three-year old letter in which one Warren Commission lawyer informs another Warren Commission lawyer: "One time Walthers was quoted as having found a bullet, but he seems to have backed away from this position".

Fortunately, the photograph was taken before Deputy Sheriff Walthers "backed away" and a million words from the administration which created the creditability gap cannot remove from the photograph the bullet which lays among pieces of President Kennedy's head.

Actually, Mr. Walthers has shown by his example how men have been forced by pressure to make untrue statements in order to support the big lie of the Warren Commission. Bullets have become non-bullets. Men with guns in the area of the grassy knoll have become non-men. Autopsy notes have been burned and interview notes have been burned. Important witnesses have been liquidated. Up becomes down, black becomes white and a team of armed men who promoted Lyndon Johnson to the presidency by assassinating President Kennedy have been magically converted into a mythical lone "communist" assassin.

The few men who have continued to be Americans and have refused to "back away" from what they saw -- men like former Deputy Sheriff Roger Craig -- have ended up losing their jobs. Conversely, many witnesses who have cooperated in the big lie by refusing to tell what they know about the truth have been given jobs in defense plants. Our office has located at least one participant in the assassination of President Kennedy who now works at a military base for the United States Government.

Deputy Sheriff Walthers' obviously false statement is simply additional evidence that the present administration of the United States Government intends to stand by its policy of encouraging witnesses to conceal the truth and of protecting the assassins of John Kennedy. The unrelenting adherence

by Washington to this policy points with increasing clarity
to involvement in the assassination of men who are now high
federal officials.
