Gentlemen:

Hereby we are addressing ourselves to you to let you know that the assassination of the President of the United States John F. Kennedy, is connected with the Revolutionary Government of Cuba. Approximately two months ago, the alleged assassin of the President, Lee Harvey Oswald, had an interview in the city of Miami with Mr. Pedro Charles, an agent of Fidel Castro in Mexico, who was in charge of delivering to the above-mentioned Lee H. Oswald the amount of seven thousand dollars. This source is official; every time that a certain lady went in the company of Pedro Charles to a night club in Miami, she saw both of them together in conference and this lady recognized him from the photographs published here in Havana. This lady resides in Havana, but her name cannot be disclosed because her escort, Pedro Charles, is currently in Mexico on a mission by the Castro Government for a cultural exchange. As soon as this lady leaves the country - in fact, she is suffering from a serious nervous breakdown - she will go to one of the countries of Central America clandestinely in order to avoid being detained by the Castro police. This is all I can inform for the time being and it is the truth; let us hope, then, that the lady in question
