Referring to my letter dated November 17, 1978 concerning the films about Kennedy I sent to C.B.C. Montreal, on November 5, 1977, you will find enclosed the photocopies of the following documents :

- The air waybill, issued on November 5, 1977
- The customs statement
- The canadian invoice of goods sold by the Exporter prior to importation for entry into Canada
- The receipt we got from the "Société Radio Canada"-Paris
- The telex sent by Radio-Canada, Paris on November 7, 1977, to Sylvie Lebel-C.B.C. Montreal, advising that the records have been sent to them
- the telex sent by Radio-Canada, Paris, to C.B.C. Montreal, on November 17, 1978, in order to notify that you never received the records.


