Fifty to 60 cases of histoplasmosis were discovered as a result of an eye survey made Sat-urday at Walkersville High School, it was learned last night.

The results of the survey, conducted by continuous from the Wilmer Institute at Johns Hopkins in Baltimore, and local physicians, were tallied last

The eye examination and skin test for the disease of the eye involved 1,198 people from the Walkersville-Woodsboro and

Fifty per cent of the townspeople tested were found to have positive reactions to the skin tests administered and several were found to have active lesions in the eye.

Aside from histoplasmosis

several cases of glaucoma were detected along with retinal de-tachments, diabetes and other eye allments. These causes have been referred to local optomo-

logists.
