

Castro To Break With Red China

HAVANA (AP)—Prime Minister Fidel Castro said today Cuba is prepared for a break in diplomatic relations with Communist China, which he accused of "launching an imperialist-type campaign against Cuba."

He also denied rumors of growing internal opposition to his Communist government.

In an angry 4½-hour speech, Castro said Peking apparently was trying to provoke a break in relations by carrying out a "new campaign of calumny" and continuing its "economic aggressions" against his country.
