Perhaps I should have taken your advice about their motives and methods, but I feel I have to try it my way and see what happens. The reasons I decided to alert them to my work ~~are~~ multi-faceted. First, since I have already published it, it is really nothing new. Second, if I contact them and give them the exact ~~story~~ <sup>lectures</sup> on the origins and development of the story (both on Kennedy and King) then they will not be able to credit the House Committee as readily. It just may help to put things in perspective and aid in the need to ask the proper questions about all of this information. Not just to use it for sensational headlines. Third, and a bit selfishly I admit, perhaps it might help me in my quest for a job in an area I sincerely wish to stay in, investigations.

So much for all of that, <sup>but</sup> I would greatly welcome any advice you could give me on what I just told you.

On other fronts...I was wondering if I could get the benefit of your knowledge on some other areas. First, is it possible to make a FOIA request on the local level?
