Dear Jonn,

In the haste to mail the other things, I forgot to make and send this copy of the Capitol Records agreement, which, as a condition of their use (or, as the case had it, misuse) of my words, promised a) to make a contribution to the Kennedy library, which it did not do b) in my name on the letter and on a prorata basis in the release. But they did not make this contribution in my name with or without that of others, cannot not, and at the time they made this contract were not in a position to make the assurance they did, having made no effort to arrange it or having made the effort and learned they could not.

In addition, because of other breaches of the verbal agreement Larry Schiller made to me prior to taping and on the tape (which he is quite capable of having edited out, but subsequently acknowledged in the presence of others), I demanded, in advance of publication, that all of it in whatever form, be returned and not be used. Instead, and despite my demand their undeniable breach of the agreement, they (and Schiller personally) caused it to be used as part of a libel against me (paranoid) in the World Journal Tribune.

I think it would be appropriate that something happen to them. I have written Livingston several times, without response, except for an apology from Schiller than carbon monoxide did not (accidentally?) kill him and the unkept promise to write in response. Subsequently, this same material was used in their vile book, I believe in further and deliberate violation of the agreement, the breach of which had already been called to their attention.

Right? Wrong? I can copy entire file if need be. Cost time; takes time.
