Today was the pitterest pill I've had to swallow in quite some years. Yesterday my family left for - moved to - Carmel. This house is like one mouldy pit now; not a stick of furniture worth kindling, just a crumpling coffee table on which sits this typewriter.

The decision to send them back to Carmel was easy at the time; the better schools, the more casual, non-urban(e) atmosphere, the good-as-can-be-expected life; all these seemed more important than proximity on a daily basis. Horse pucky!!!

I'll commute on weekends when I can. I'm so damned used to immediate married life, though, it is going to be painful without them. There is no other way that I can pursue my current commitments and still feel that I am not inflicting an obtrusive cityfied existence on my loved ones. Thank God I wasn't borne last month. What a miserable future to have to face.

I'm going to hole up in a small apartment when the house clears. It doesn't have to be much for me to hang my hat and underward around.

I am drafting a memorandum to Counsel out here; it'll be a statement on your current and future legal circumstance, both applicable to the role to be played by our group out here.

The firm - O'Gara, McGuire and Nestel - has been given a gradual spoon-feeding on the matter, books and conversation.
